Read: John 15:9-17

Jesus had explained to the disciples that they must remain connected to him to grow and produce fruit. In our reading today Jesus continues but goes on to talk about love. Jesus explains that the greatest thing the disciples can do for one another is love one another – this is what they have been called to do, and by loving each other, and everyone else in the community around them they will be able to produce more and more fruit, fruit that will last. Love is important to God and so it must be important to us as well – we need to love others – just as God loves us.
